All espresso based coffees are served with a double shot and with semi-skimmed milk as standard. Drinks are available decaffeinated, with skimmed milk, soya milk, rice milk or almond milk and with flavoured syrups (vanilla, caramel or hazelnut) at no extra charge.

Welcome to the Orangery Tea Room

We hope you enjoy your time here with us. Our services and facilities are cared for and provided by community members, many of whom are volunteers. We are an international Christian community with team members coming from many different nations. For some, English is their second language so please bear with them. If there is any difficulty which a team member cannot help with, please ask for the supervisor on duty.

The Orangery opened as a tea room in 2013. The building itself dates back to 1777 and was built by Lancelot Capability Brown as a “seven bayed Greenhouse” at the end of his period at Ashburnham Place. Originally it had a central doorway with side and central beds for exotic plants and trees. In the early 1830’s the door was moved to its current position to make way for the planting of what are now some of the oldest surviving camellias in the country. The Orangery was refaced with brick in the 1850’s at the same time as the house.

We are open Tuesday to Sunday from 10.30am to 5.00pm. (We are closed on Mondays) We may be closed for other dates during the year. Advance notice of closures are displayed at our front door, on our website and Facebook page. We also have cards with current confirmed dates which are available at the counter.

Table Bookings

We only take table bookings afternoon teas (2 - 20 people).
